1. Welsh Government PT confirmed that we have completed and forwarded the stakeholder consultation papers as provided by the Cardiff Capital Region, covering the outline of the Regional Transport Strategy. The CEO Transport Wales James Price, was approached at the meeting and asked that if we secured (1) Grip 3, (2) UK Funding and (3) Wales Funding would he be prepared to take on our project through to completion. His response was very encouraging as he said he would.

Roger Hoggins, Head of Operations, Monmouthshire County Council indicated that they hope to be producing a video covering transport in the area and that MAGOR will be included in the filming.
