MCC have contacted both Network Rail and Transport for Wales (TFW) supporting the ambitions of a Magor/Undy Station. This is being led by Nicholas Tulp. Presently were waiting for responses. .2 2.3 TH has now made contact with Christian Schmidt of MCC He has advised that contact is being made with land owners regarding access for survey, which should be completed by the end of 2027. .2	Senedd Meeting 8th Aug 2026 TH PI & LH at the kind invitation of Peredur Owen Griffiths MS, went to The Senedd to meet representatives of the new Welsh Government. Peredur Owen Griffiths MS, along with Donna Cushing MS and Matthew Jones MS. The meeting was useful, productive and enjoyable giving us the opportunity to bring them up to speed with the MAGOR campaign, following on from the previous week's visit from Deputy Transport Minister Mark Hooper MS, to our Walk to School Initiative. MAGOR is delighted that we are developing a business-like relationship with Plaid Cymru Welsh Government.

We were advised that arrangements can not be proceeded until the station designs have been finalised. We have expressed our surprise and considered opinion, <i>"that a plan needs to be drawn up well in advance of a station being built"</i>.		
.5	Platform Positioning As mentioned above, TH has requested, if our Member of Parliament Catherine Fookes could facilitate a Network Rail/TFW meeting with MAGOR, to discuss the Platform curvature alignment. Raised in our GRIP procedures by Mott Macdonald there are questions that need clarification in order to promote our original plan A in the circa 2017 GRIP.
